### **FIELD OF STUDY: Final Examinations**

Duration: Two semesters
Frequency of Repetition: Annually
Admission Requirements: Admission to the artistic examination in the ZKF requires the completion of all courses from the other study areas and MA specializations.
Curriculum Content and Objectives: Completion of the master's degree.
Notes on Individual Courses: The MA thesis is to be written on the basis of the course "MA Thesis Colloquium". The detailed implementation regulations of the artistic examination are determined by the individual institutes after approval by the study commission..

## **FIELD OF STUDY: MASTER OF ARTS SPECIALIZATIONS**

### **MA SPECIALIZATION: Cultural Management – Foundations**

Duration: Two semesters
Frequency of Repetition: Annually
Admission Requirements: None
Curriculum Content and Objectives: In this MA specialization, students acquire the fundamentals of cultural business theory, public relations and marketing and relate these to their work as musicians. They gain insight into the basics of public funding and sponsorship and acquire an understanding of the processes of cultural business. The students will be able to perceive their own artistic work in the cultural sector and to place it in a context of public funding and private financing, as well as to draw on economic and legal principles for their organizational activities. They will be aware of ways to communicate with the target groups of the public about their project and to recognize and develop their position in the market.

Duration: Two semesters
Frequency of Repetition: Annually
Admission Requirements: Completion of the MA specialization “Cultural Management – Foundations”.
Curriculum Content and Objectives: Students gain insight into the structure, organization and design of cultural projects and learn the necessary technical requirements of EDV in the context of practical application.

Curriculum Content and Objectives: Intensive examination of the working fields of early music from a scholarly and practical perspective. Targeted reflection on the practical music pedagogical implementation of the acquired knowledge in one's own teaching.

### **MA SPECIALIZATION: Improvisation for Classical Musicians**

Duration: Two semesters
Frequency of Repetition: Annually
Admission Requirements: None
Curriculum Content and Objectives: Intensive study of the theory and practice of improvisation for primarily 'classically' trained musicians. Knowing and being able to apply styles of improvisation. Gain an insight into the historical development of improvisation in different eras beyond the traditional development in the history of jazz.
