

MARKUS SCHIRMER

PIANO

Energy, expression and emotion characterise Austrian top pianist Markus Schirmer's music-making.

No matter where he tours he receives audience acclaim for his charismatic musicianship and his ability to tell vivid stories with the instrument. One of his reviews sums him up precisely: "A pied piper on the piano...music that comes straight from the heart, the brain and the fingertips."

Soon he was to take most of the prominent concert halls and festivals by storm.

He works with major orchestras and conductors such as the Vienna Philharmonic, Royal Philharmonic Orchestra London, Tokyo Symphony Orchestra, Mariinsky Orchestra St. Petersburg, Chamber Orchestra of Europe, and many more.



SASKIA GIORGINI PIANO

Saskia Giorgini performs in acclaimed recitals in the world's greatest concert halls: Elbphilharmonie in Hamburg, Meistersingerhalle in Nuremberg, Liederhalle in Stuttgart, Beethovenhalle in Bonn, Konzerthaus & Musikverein in Vienna, Suntory Hall in Tokyo, Wigmore Hall in London, Philharmonia in St. Petersburg.

As a soloist, she collaborates with orchestras such as the Tokyo Metropolitan Symphony Orchestra, (..); her special affinity for Chamber Music regularly brings Saskia Giorgini together with renowned partners including Ian Bostridge, Martin Fröst, Janine Jansen and many more.

Saskia Giorgini is the winner of the International Mozart Competition Salzburg 2016 and her latest album "Consolations" (Liszt, Pentatone) was awarded with a Diapason d'Or.



ANDREAS FRÖLICH

PIANO

Andreas Frölich teaches as a professor at the Cologne University of Music and Dance and regularly gives masterclasses. His students have won more than 150 1st and 2nd prizes at international piano competitions.

His concert activities have taken him to the world's largest concert halls in Europe, the USA, South America, Asia and as far afield as South Africa and Australia, as well as to major international music festivals, both as a soloist with numerous internationally renowned orchestras, as well as pianist with the Mendelssohn Trio Berlin and with the Ensemble Wien (including concertmaster and members of the Vienna Philharmonic).

His artistic work also includes more than 100 radio productions for all major German broadcasters as well as 40 CDs, many of which have won awards.





HENJA SEMMLER VIOLIN

Trained by R. Kussmaul, Th. Brandis and Gerhard Schulz, among others, Henja Semmler was honoured at the L. Spohr Competition and the German Music Competition.

In 2006 she founded the Oberon Trio, with which she has since performed in major concert halls and festivals, as well as with partners like T. Zimmermann, J. Widmann or I. Bostridge.

She was a founding member of the Mahler Chamber Orchestra and the Lucerne Festival Orchestra. She has been engaged as a guest concertmaster by the Mahler Chamber Orchestra, the Swedish Radio Orchestra, the Scottish Chamber Orchestra and the Kammerakademie Potsdam, among others.

She has taken up a violin professorship at the MUK Vienna since 2018 and at the HMT Rostock since 2023.



GABRIEL SCHWABE

Gabriel Schwabe has won the Grand Prix Emanuel Feuermann in Berlin, the Concours Rostropovich in Paris and the Pierre Fournier Award in London.

As a soloist, he has worked with orchestras like the London Philharmonia, the Vienna Radio Symphony Orchestra and the NDR Radiophilharmony under renowned conductors such as Marek Janowski, Adam Fischer and Joanna Mallwitz.

His chamber music partners have included Isabelle Faust, Christian Tetzlaff, Lars Vogt, Roland Pöntinen and Nicholas Rimmer.

His recordings as an exclusive artist for NAXOS are regularly celebrated by the international press. He teaches at the HfMT Cologne and the Maastricht Conservatory.



CHRISTINE HOOCK

DOUBLE BASS

Christine Hoock inspires as a double bass soloist, chamber and orchestral musician at concert performances and masterclasses worldwide. Born in Mainz, she brings the fascinating possibilities of playing the double bass as a soloist to concert halls with her ease and virtuosity.

This international prizewinner has performed at the Schleswig-Holstein Music Festival, Aurora Chamber Music Festival, Lucerne and San Sebastian Festival as well as at the Berlin and Salzburg Festivals.

As a versatile double bass virtuoso, Christine Hoock can be heard in classical performances as well as in crossgenre and innovative constellations of world, jazz and electronic music. This is reflected in her varied discography.





ADAM WALKER FLUTE

Adam Walker is recognised as a multifaceted artist and outstanding ambassador for his instrument, committed to bringing the flute to new audiences - from solo concertos to large-scale orchestral works.

With an inquisitive and creative approach to programming, Adam Walker's range includes everything from lesser-known French Baroque repertoire to new commissions.

He has given world premieres of concertos by composers such as Brett Dean, Kevin Puts and Huw Watkins, as well as masterful compositions by Kaija Saariaho and Weinberg.

As a soloist, Walker regularly performs with the major British orchestras.









JOHANN HINDLER **MATTHIAS SCHORN**

CLARINET

Johann Hindler is a member of the Vienna State Opera Orchestra and the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra. where he has played under all the great conductors of our time. He has been a highly successful teacher for many years: from 1980 to 1995 as an assistant to Prof Peter Schmidl, and from 1995 as a lecturer with his own class at the Vienna University of Music, where he was also appointed professor. Today, graduates of his class form the young generation of clarinetists and solo clarinetists in many major orchestras.

Matthias Schorn teaches at the Music and Arts Private University of the City of Vienna, holds masterclasses worldwide and works as a columnist for a range specialist magazines. He is a member of the Vienna State Opera Orchestra and the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra. As a soloist, he has performed with renowned orchestras like the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra, the German Symphony Orchestra Berlin, the Konzerthausorchester Berlin and many others.

As the founder of the PalmKlang festival and the Faltenradio ensemble and as an artist in residence, he regularly creates exciting new dramaturgical concepts.

LECTURERS WOODWIND INSTRUMENTS

SOPHIE DERVAUX PHILIPP TUTZER

BASSOON

Sophie Dervaux is principal bassoonist with the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra. She was previously principal contrabassoonist with the Berlin Philharmonic Orchestra. She has won prizes at numerous prestigious competitions and has performed as a soloist with famous orchestras such as the Vienna Philharmonic, the Konzerthausorchester Berlin, the Orchestre National de Lyon and many more. Sophie Dervaux teaches at the Music and Arts Private University of the City of Vienna and gives masterclasses at renowned conservatories and music universities worldwide.

Philipp Tutzer is Professor of Bassoon at the Anton Bruckner Private University in Linz and regularly gives masterclasses. Engagements as a soloist have taken him to venues including the Berlin Philharmonie, the Salzburg Festival and the Vienna Musikverein. Philipp Tutzer has been principal bassoonist in the Mozarteum Orchestra Salzburg since 2007 and has performed with the Munich Philharmonic, the Camerata Salzburg, the Munich Chamber Orchestra, the Rotterdam Philharmonic Orchestra, the NDR Hamburg, and the Berlin Philharmonic.









MICHAEL OMAN, MAURICE STEGER

RECORDER

Michael Oman has made an outstanding international name for himself as a recorder soloist and ensemble leader, is one of the most distinguished and versatile recorder players of his generation, having a wide-ranging repertoire at his disposal. Michael Oman founded the "Austrian Baroque Company" and the "Austrian Recorder Academy", which aims to provide young, highly talented recorder players with the best possible artistic support in the form of courses, concerts, and recitals.

Maurice Steger, also known as "Paganini", "wizard", "the world's leading recorder player" or the "electrifying and inspiring conductor", is not only known for his astonishing technique, but also for his charisma, his intellect and a very special sensitivity for music. Maurice Steger demonstrates all of this to his audiences, inspiring them with his intense tone and endless energy in a wide variety of concert formats all over the world, whether playing or conducting.









CAMPBELL DIAMOND GUITAR

The Australian guitarist Campbell **Diamond** is a university lecturer at the Anton Bruckner University in Linz.

Concert tours have taken him as a soloist and Chamber Musician throughout Australia, in Asia to Japan, Korea, India and China, in South America to Brazil, as well as throughout Europe.

Campbell Diamond has been honoured with over 30 prizes at national and international guitar competitions.

His debut CD was released in 2018 as 1st prize winner of the 25th Koblenz International Guitar Competition.

It has already received overwhelmingly positive reviews, in particular from the magazine Akustik Guitar.

LECTURERS TRUMPET



JÜRGEN ELLENSOHN FLORIAN KLINGLER

TRUMPET

Jürgen Ellensohn teaches as Professor of Trumpet at the Würzburg University of Music. As a musician, he has worked with many of the most renowned orchestras and conductors and was principal trumpet with the Frankfurt Radio Symphony Orchestra and the Bern Symphony Orchestra. He devotes himself to Chamber Music with great enthusiasm. He is a member of Pro Brass and The Philharmonic Brass, among others. He was also a member of "The Percussive Planet Ensemble" until the end of Martin Grubinger's career.

Florian Klingler is Professor of Trumpet at the Anton Bruckner University. His orchestral career began in 1997 as principal trumpet in the NDR Elbphilharmonieorchester Hamburg and he moved to the same position with the Munich Philharmonic in September 2000. In order to devote more time to his teaching activities, he decided to take up the position of substitute trumpeter in 2020. Solo appearances have brought him together with orchestras such as the Munich Philharmonic Orchestra, the Munich Symphony Orchestra, the Stuttgart Philharmonic Orchestra and the Lower Rhine Symphony Orchestra Mönchengladbach.

HEIDI LUOSUJÄRVI

AKKORDEON

Finnish Accordionist **Heidi Luosujärvi** has been a university professor for Accordion at the Anton Bruckner University since October 2022.

Luosujärvi studied at the Sibelius Academy in Helsinki and at the Folkwang University of the Arts in Essen.

She has won several prizes at international music competitions as a soloist and chamber musician.

Her busy concert schedule, documented by many radio and television recordings, has taken her all over Europe, to Asia, the Middle East and the USA.

She has premiered numerous works and collaborated with many composers.











BOGDAN BACANU, LEONHARD SCHMIDINGER, **CHRISTOPH SIETZEN**

PERCUSSION

This course will provide opportunities for solo literature and orchestral literature on the various percussion instruments as well as for orchestral literature.

There will be the opportunity for ensemble playing and Chamber Music, as well as working on basic technical issues.

The three teachers each focus on different repertoires and instruments;

Bogdan Bacanu for's solo marimba, Leonhard **Schmidinger** for orchestral and solo literature on timpani and drums and **Christoph Sietzen** for solo and ensemble literature in general.

Theoretical knowledge alone is not enough to excel on stage. It takes action to face the situation in front of an audience again and again. Individual performance coaching offers this opportunity through an appropriate performance setting (including the audience).

Constructive feedback – referring to general stage behaviour AND individual parameters - is an essential part of the scholarly and specifically tailored coaching that is applied.

BIOFEEDBACK

INDIVIDUAL COACHING: BIOFEEDBACK AND RELAXATION

Biofeedback is a measurement method in which physiological processes such as pulse, breathing, and muscle tension are measured and reported back. The measured parameters express the balance of the autonomic nervous system and provide information about the current (stress) state of the organism.

Specifically, statements can be made about how stress in the broadest sense affects the organism's ability to cope with stress and regenerate, with particular attention being paid to regenerative processes and the development of resources. From the insights gained, change processes can be derived in the spirit of maintaining health.
